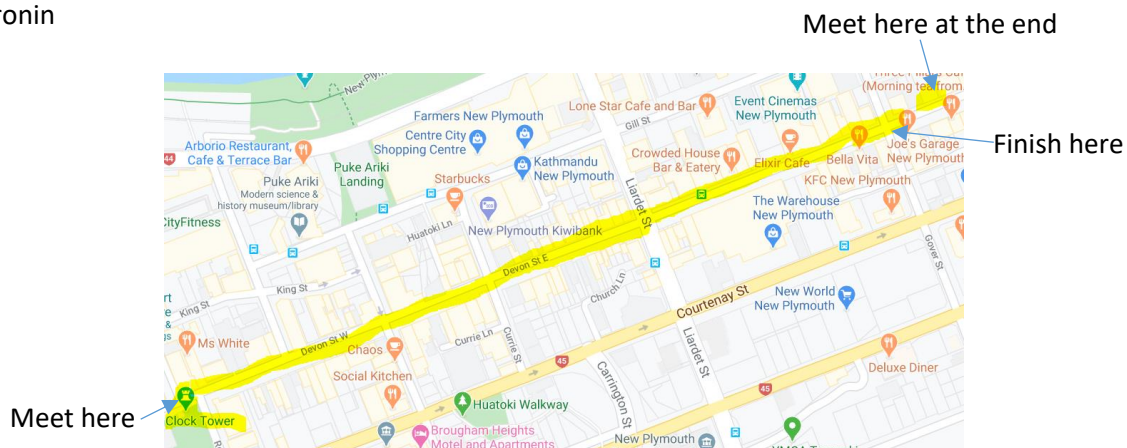
Parents, siblings and family members are welcome to dress up and walk with the group too.
